Advanced Driver Assistance Systems, also known as ADAS, are now standard in most new vehicles worldwide. From reversing cameras and blind spot warnings to more advanced features such as adaptive cruise control and driver drowsiness detection, almost all modern cars are equipped with some form of this technology.
