Sharine Milne and Tim McRae Awarded the MTA Queensland 2022 VET Trainer Scholarships

The Motor Trades Association of Queensland (MTA Queensland) is pleased to announce the first round of the 2022 Vocational Education and Training (VET) Trainer Scholarships have been awarded to Sharine Milne from R.H.D Classic Supplies and Services in Townsville, and Tim McRae from Carline Automotive in Bundaberg.

The scholarships are a fantastic opportunity for automotive professionals to advance their careers by undertaking a Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40116); a highly sought-after course that provides the skills and knowledge to deliver training in the VET sector. Valued at \$2,500, the scholarships are awarded to one female and one male candidate each round.

Sharine Milne, otherwise known as 'Spanner,' is the owner and head mechanic of R.H.D Classic Supplies and Services, a motorcycle service and repair shop in Townsville. She is a qualified mechanic and parts interpreter and holds a Cert II & III in office administration and a Cert V in management. Spanner has worked in the industry for almost 20 years, owning her own business for the last 10. While she already provides on-the-job work experience to apprentices, Spanner hopes to use this scholarship to build upon her skills and deliver a higher quality of training.

Spanner said, "I was given a chance to show what I have achieved and my commitment to continuous learning. Now I want to be a better teacher and pass that on. It doesn't matter where you started, VET has a pathway that will pave your way to the next goal no matter where it lies."
