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Auto Women Announces Round 1, 2024 Scholarship Awardees

The Motor Trades Association of Queensland (MTA Queensland) is excited to announce the recipients for Round 1 of the 2024 Auto Women Scholarships. We extend our congratulations to Sophie-Jo Forsythe from S J Fitting Services who has been awarded the Leading Edge scholarship (valued at \$3,490), and Maud-Ellen Berge from SEQ Campers, who has been awarded the Executive Ready scholarship (valued at \$8,490).

Proudly supported by MTA Queensland, Spirit Super, and Women & Leadership Australia, the Auto Women Scholarships aim to support females in early-career and mid-level positions from across the automotive industry advance their careers through two fully-funded, high-impact training programs.

The first course, Leading Edge, is designed to assist females in early-career positions transition into confident, capable, and motivated leaders. This scholarship has been awarded to Sophie-Jo Forsythe, Leading Hand at S J Fitting Services, Rubyvale.

A qualified light vehicle mechanic, Sophie-Jo is committed to promoting diversity and empowering women to thrive in a traditionally male-dominated automotive industry. By undertaking the Leading Edge course, Sophie hopes to gain comprehensive leadership training to support her ambition of becoming a role model for women and underrepresented cohorts in the automotive industry and pave the way for those entering the workforce.

"Being the recipient of this scholarship means a lot to me, it will help me to develop the necessary skills and knowledge on how to be able to contribute further to my trade and the people I work with and to be able to exceed expectations of being a leading hand and

knowing how to correctly communicate and manage tasks that may be thrown my way and delegated to me," said Sophie-Jo.

The second course, Executive Ready, is designed to stretch mid-level leaders and propel them towards executive-level positions, bolstering their skills and mindsets. This scholarship has been awarded to Maud-Ellen Berge, the General Manager at SEQ Campers, Nambour.

With five years of experience in the retail industry, including the last two years as General Manager at SEQ Campers, Maud-Ellen is excited to take on the opportunity to complete the Executive Ready course to expand her leadership credentials and deliver growth in her career.

Background:
