MTA Institute Expands Popular Auto Ready Program to Regional Queensland

MTA Institute (RTO No. 31529), the leading industry-owned provider of automotive apprenticeships and training in Queensland, is expanding its popular Auto Ready program to the regions. High school students from across Cairns, Rockhampton, and Townsville will have the opportunity to get hands-on experience working with real vehicles while exploring the many exciting and prosperous career pathways available in the automotive industry.

During the five-day program, students undertaking the course will learn a range of tasks relating to using and maintaining tools and equipment, as well as identifying and inspecting the mechanical and electrical components and systems of light vehicles, all while under the guidance of MTA Institute's highly skilled and qualified Technical Trainers.

This nationally accredited program contributes three units of competency towards an AUR20720 – Certificate II in Automotive Vocational Preparation qualification, while also earning participants 1 QCE point. Not only this, but the program is subsidised through the Queensland Government under the Certificate 3 Guarantee program. Training is provided fee-free for VET in School students.

Initially held at the MTA Institute's state-of-the-art workshop in Brisbane, the Auto Ready course expanded its reach in 2022 to regional Queensland. Courses were held in Mackay and Dysart, and a partnership was formed with Glenmore State High School in Rockhampton to offer the program at the school's trade training facility. Excitingly, the program is now set to extend its presence even further north!
